

## **Heroes' Club Assistant Applicant Information**

### **What is Heroes' Club?**

Heroes' Club is a Biblically-centered club for students in Kindergarten through 5th grade.

Meeting every Monday when Frederick County has school, from school dismissal to 5:30 p.m., we will look at trust, courage, forgiveness, obedience and love, through the eyes of our Biblical heroes.

Students will move between snack time, play time, a Bible story and activity, and homework time. Growing closer to one another and closer to God, students will gain greater self-confidence and grow in their faith looking upon themselves as the heroes they are!

### **What are my responsibilities as an Assistant?**

Assist as needed with snack time, responsible for leading play time, assist as needed during the Bible lesson and activity, assist as needed during homework time. Take the initiative to look for opportunities to help adult leaders and to interact with students as much as possible. We are here for the children of Heroes' Club — no socializing with other Heroes' Club Assistants please.

Ensure compliance with Safe Sanctuary and safety guidelines (never alone with a student, proper parent/guardian sign-out procedures, etc.)

Provide your own transportation to and from Salem Church on Mondays when school is in session and dismisses at normal time. Plan to stay until 6:00 p.m. to ensure pick-up of all students and allow time to review/plan for the following week.

Set a great example in speech, life, love, faith, and purity (I Timothy 4:12).

Open Communication: let a Heroes' Club adult know of any problems, questions, or concerns within the team or with any student.
